NSDC project aims at 500,000 jobs

New Delhi:

The National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC), a Central government agency, has tied up with recruitment company TMI Group to help graduates from smaller cities and towns get jobs in the corporate sector.

Under the project, TMI will set up employability assessment centres at 900 colleges across the country, where graduates will be trained to meet specific job requirements before they start working.

“We are looking for one to three month courses. The process is demand driven, which means jobs will be created as per the need of the industry,” said T. Muralidhar, executive chairman of TMI. The project aims to provide nearly 500,000 jobs over 10 years.
