NSDC to train participants for WorldSkills Competition

Mumbai, May 17: The National Skill Development Corporation has joined hands with NASSCOM, CII, FICCI and other bodies to undertake nationwide search for skilled youth who will get opportunity to represent the country at WorldSkills 2011 to be held in London later this year.

The participants will be selected for 16 disciplines including car painting, plumbing and heating, wall and floor tiling, mould making, electronics, web design, fashion technology and jewellery design, among others, NSDC said in a statement.

The process of selections would start next week and would be completed by the middle of June. The chosen candidates would then undergo coaching under experts drawn from the particular field.

The WorldSkills Competition will be held in London on October 5-8. **PTI.**
