Terms of Reference for District Wise Human Resource and Skill Requirements Study for the State of Bihar

Introduction

The National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) was set up as part of the governments' coordinated action in the skills space with the specific target of skilling / up skilling 402 million people by 2022, mainly by fostering private sector initiatives in this area. In order to achieve this target NSDC has been working on three key mandates:

- **Create:** Proactively catalyze creation of large, quality vocational training institutions
- **Fund:** Reduce risk by providing patient capital and improve returns by providing viability gap funding
- **Enable:** Facilitate the creation of support systems required for skill development

Developing a research base is one of the critical activities of the organization. NSDC conducts studies to understand the geographical and sector wise skill requirements and on various subjects that can influence and enable skilling ecosystem in India. NSDC has conducted human resource and skill requirement study for 24 high priority sectors and district wise studies for all states, except the state of Bihar.

NSDC would like to hire a consultant to undertake a study to estimate the skilling requirements in the workforce at the **district level** across the state of Bihar in India over the time period of 2017-2022 with an outcome in the form of implementation plan for livelihood generation and skill development of local communities including **informal/unorganized sector** within the state.

The new deadline for submission of technical and financial proposal is extended to **8th of May 2017**.
